"Firstly, the dual technology, low and high pressure, allows use on medium and large surfaces but also on smaller surfaces or objects.

In addition, the ACT dispenser is essential for independently adjusting air and product in order to find the best mix of finish and yield and apply all kinds of paints and varnishes, in the carpentry, steelworking, construction and marine sectors.

The set-up of the machine and the variety of accessories do the rest, By 'the rest' I mean everything that is useful in daily work: convenience of transport, ease of maintenance, time and material savings, guaranteed results, and respect and sustainability in use for people and the environment".

Such a well thought-out piece of equipment would already mean all our problems are over... but at Rigo® we did some further thinking.

"We put ourselves in the painters' shoes and we thought that CART TURBINA would be even more valuable if we re-assessed its characteristics starting out from specific uses", says Vincenzo Cattaneo, the Rigo® general sales manager.

"So we opted for two solutions, CT9-I and CT18-E, the former dedicated to use in industry, the latter in construction.



CT9-I, with its smaller tank, is certainly more suitable for painting jobs in steelwork, the marine sector and carpentry - sectors using less dense paints (therefore, less product needed).

Also, in the industrial sector, bi- or tri-component paints with limited pot-life are used, and the reduced tank size makes for more careful consumption.

Then we should factor in the sizes of the surfaces and objects to be painted, which are usually smaller than walls and floors. Lastly, we also considered cleaning operations, which are more delicate tasks due to the use of solvents.
